The new musical features music and lyrics by David Eric Davis, with a book by Davis and Sam Forman. Stephen Brackett will direct the NYMF staging that runs Oct. 6-16 at the 45th Street Theater.

Larsen (Hairspray, Most Happy Fella), Weisberg (South Pacific, Legally Blonde) and Coker-Jones (Evil Dead, Fame) will be joined onstage by Heath Calvert (Good Vibrations), Kate Rockwell (Legally Blonde) and Leif Huckman.
